## **FAMILY REUNION VISA**

- 1. Visa application form
- 2. Recent passport-size photograph
- 3. Passport whose validity extends at least three months after the visa requested expiration
- 4. National ID (*gensiya*)
- 5. If foreigner living in Iraq, residence permit
- 6. Visa fee (please see the attached list)
- 7. Authorization ("*Nulla Osta*") issued by the Italian Immigration Office to the family member who is resident in Italy
- 8. Any ID (Italian ID card, Italian residence permit) of the family member who is resident in Italy
- 9. Iraqi family status certificate, listing all family members, in original, with a translation into Italian, legalized by the Iraqi Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- 10. Other Iraqi documents proving the family relation: birth certificates, marriage certificate (if applicable), in original, with a translation into Italian, legalized by the Iraqi Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- 11. If a minor (under 18) applying for family reunion will not be living in Italy with both parents: written consent, notarized and translated, of the parent that is not traveling to Italy. The parent giving consent must also be present at the Embassy for the Visa interview.

## **IMPORTANT**

- In case of documents in Arabic, they must be accompanied by an English, French or Italian translation of an official translator
- Visa Office will process the application and lodged documents and it may request additional ones at its discretion
- Submission of required documents does not automatically guarantee the issuance of a visa
